Introduction of 2012 Board

Neighborhood Watch Presentation: MCPD 6th district Community Services Officer Scott Zimmerman provided an overview of the Neighborhood Watch Program and associated services. Ofcr Zimmerman also provided the results of a walk-thru of the MWHOA neighborhoods that he performed along with MW residents in Oct. He mentioned that our neighborhood has several path systems and that despite outdated street lighting, overall the neighborhood looks good. Residents should be vigilant about potential theft from auto and possible burglaries, both of which are prevalent in this area of MontCo. **Ofcr Zimmerman** also mentioned that a useful site to monitor crimes is www.crimereports.com.

Secretary's Highlights from 2012 Minutes: Rob read a summary of the highlights from all of the 2012 minutes. Attached.

Treasurer's report: Ed provided a summary of MWHOA financials from the 2012/13 budget (attached).

Nominating Cmte/Election of Board of Directors: John and Steve were nominated for twoyear terms by the Nominating Cmte (Michele Heffner, Heather Patton) and elected to the board by unanimous vote of the membership.

Discussion of new MWHOA signage: Extensive discussion by the membership on the desire and benefits of updated signage took place. The proposed cost for 2 new signs from the 2013 budget (\$16k) was not exorbitant to the members. While that estimate includes a MontCo permitting fee, the membership recommended that long-term maintenance of the sign (cleaning, repairs, etc) also be built into the final cost. John mentioned that perhaps Greenlink could provide maintenance of the sign as part of their contract. Reflective paint was also recommended by a member for the signs to enhance visibility.

Website: Board agreed to add more links to the website for County services.

Secretary's Highlights from 2012 Minutes

MWHOA Annual Meeting - Nov 13, 2012

- New officers were elected at the November 2011 annual meeting and began their service on the board in January
- In January, the link to the Montgomery County holiday recycling/yard waste pickup schedule was placed on the HOA website to make planning easier for residents (trash still provided by private contractor with a slightly different schedule – see website)
- The board heard a proposal from Verizon in January on plans to provide FiOS to all homes in MWHOA along existing utility easements, and also granted Verizon permission to bury cable in the common space behind the townhomes at Kinglet Pl and Swallow Ct in preparation for that service
- MWHOA residents met and participated in a Spring Workday in March over 10 bags of trash and other items were collected as part of our efforts to maintain our common areas
- The Spring Survey was conducted in late April overwhelming majority of homeowners were in compliance with our covenants, and board sent friendly letters to those who were not
- Our annual limited bulk trash pickup took place in May
- Rob worked with MontCo police to schedule Neighborhood Watch training in September despite limited turnout by MW homeowners, attendees gathered a lot of helpful information from Officer Zimmerman. We will also be loosely linking up with Flower Hill HOA, which will forward any relevant info.
- The Fall Survey was conducted in late September
- Two audits of MWHOA finances from previous years (2010 and 2011) were completed and paid for in the fall the HOA received a rating of "very good" and is in good stead financially.
- Officer Zimmerman of MontCo police kindly accompanied board members on a walk-thru of HOA neighborhoods with an eye on lighting and other safety issues on Oct 25.
- The board solicited quotes for replacement of the fence around the pond, which was in disrepair, and the fence was replaced in early November MontCo environmental engineers also determined that the pond contains a sinkhole that needs to be repaired and that will be paid for by the county.
